## **Doing the Science**

- 1. Start the Zero Sum Security Simulation.
- 2. Read about the threat level provided on the screen.
- 3. Move guards to staging area (upper-right hand corner box area).
- 4. Drag and release security guards to different areas to best protect the port.
- 5. Dragging and releasing a security guard to the top right picture will transfer security guards to the other port if more manpower is needed.
- 6. Select "Switch" at any time to switch between the ports.
- 7. After you switch to the second port, the security guard will be on the upper right boardwalk. Select and drag the security guard to the desired location.
- 8. After you are satisfied with the guards' positions, select "Run" to view the security and annoyance levels. Select "Personal Craft", "Cargo Ships", "Cruise Ships", and "Overall" to view the security and annoyance level for each category. Record these levels into Table 1 below.
